In September, 1999, Texas enacted its groundbreaking retail electric deregulation law. Although not immediate in effect, the legislation eventually ushered in some of the biggest changes ever for Texas electricity consumers. No longer would giant, vertical-integrated utilities maintain their monopoly grip on home electricity service. No longer would Austin political appointees determine directly the price of air conditioning and lighting in all parts of Texas. In commemoration of the 20th anniversary of the law, the Texas Coalition for Affordable Power has released an updated version of its signature report, *Electric Deregulation in Texas: A Market Chronicle*. The book, organized chronologically in a year-by-year fashion, describes key deregulation-related events, beginning with those years prior to the adoption of the 1999 law and up through 2019. It includes more than 20 sequential chapters, each focusing on individual years. The report updates an earlier version first released in 2009 by TCAP for the law's 10-year anniversary.

Federal policymakers and program managers are continually seeking ways to better achieve agencies' missions and program results, in other words, they are seeking ways to improve accountability. A key factor in helping achieve such outcomes and minimize operational problems is to implement appropriate internal control. Effective internal control also helps in managing change to cope with shifting environments and evolving demands and priorities. As programs change and as agencies strive to improve operational processes and implement new technological developments, management must continually assess and evaluate its internal control to assure that the control activities being used are effective and updated when necessary. The Federal Managers' Financial Integrity Act of 1982 (FMFIA) requires the General Accounting Office (GAO) to issue standards for internal control in government. The standards provide the overall framework for establishing and maintaining internal control and for identifying and addressing major performance and management challenges, and areas at greatest risk of fraud, waste, abuse and mismanagement. This report explores the Five Standards for Internal Control as identified by GAO for policymakers and program managers: - Control Environment - Risk Assessment - Control Activities - Information and Communications - Monitoring These standards apply to all aspects of an agency's operations: programmatic, financial, and compliance. However, they are not intended to limit or interfere with duly granted authority related to developing legislation, rule-making, or other discretionary policy-making in an agency. These standards provide a general framework. In implementing these standards, management is responsible for developing the detailed policies, procedures, and practices to fit their agency's operations and to ensure that they are built into and an integral part of operations. Indeed, more people die annually from medication errors than from workplace injuries. All of this is captured within the comprehensive collection of experience and emotion that these verses aim to illustrate. Definite meanings and complex messages inherent to each poem undoubtedly vary significantly according to distinct readers within their own individualized contexts. Abstract meanings may stem from the inherent nature of particular word placements. It is an abstraction which contributes significantly to the exploration of the variety of observable meanings and subjective interpretations that might arise throughout these works. A basic sense of structure is created with this writing approach that strives for a basic overall coherence, while also relying on a spontaneous writing style that encourages complexity. Each poem is rooted in a pattern of thought which itself is connected to a larger meaning which has not yet been fully defined. Generally speaking, the words begin to form cohesive dialects that immediately become interpretable responses to the patterns of thought that were involved in their creation. In other words, nothing herein is entirely concrete. Readers' experiences create highly individualized interpretations of a writing style which is abstract in nature at times, yet remains fully within the realm of comprehension. These are real free verse poems, created in the moment using only enough editing to prevent unwanted misspellings and unnecessary punctuation errors. The rest of it is left in its purest, most natural, and holiest state. It is a poetry rooted in innocence, and drawn from that place inside of all of us where true inspiration can only be found at certain times. These words will always remain where they were originally placed. Staying true to the moment involves respecting the significance of the experience of a deeper connection to a more meaningful and otherworldly realm from which the almost supernatural ability required to write these poems is derived. These writings speak to a place of unity that exists among all people, and which manifests at times through the work of those who perhaps feel a strong connection to a larger universal interconnectedness. A basic unity within all things truly exists, but everyone is not yet willing to accept this fact. These poems truly are rooted from within this place of unity, and have themselves manifested by connecting to such a divine intelligence. Wanderings within otherworldly planes of existence, as well as glimpses into certain otherwise unnoticed perspectives on life all contribute significantly to the overall success of the writing. A powerful mixture of the sacred combined with an aura of the profane facilitates a certain surreal balance reminiscent of the ethereal dreamscapes to which my imagination travels when I write these lingering scraps of hope in their initial state of finality. The last part of this book is a surprise, and has never been published until now. Although Whitehead's widely divergent books complicate overarching categorization, Derek C. Maus argues that they are linked by their skepticism toward the ostensible wisdom inherited from past generations and the various forms of "stories" that transmit it. Whitehead, best known for his Pulitzer Prize winning novel The Underground Railroad, bids readers to accompany him on challenging, often open-ended literary excursions designed to reexamine—and frequently defy—accepted notions of truth. Understanding Colson Whitehead unravels the parallel structures found within Whitehead's books from his 1999 debut The Intuitionist through 2019's The Nickel Boys, for which he won his second Pulitzer Prize for Fiction. By first imitating and then violating their conventions, Whitehead attempts to transcend the limits of the formulas of the genres in which he seems to write. Whitehead similarly tests subject matter, again imitating and then satirizing various forms of conventional wisdom as a means of calling out unexamined, ignored, or malevolent aspects of American culture. Although it is only one of many subjects that Whitehead addresses, race is often central to his work. It serves as a prime example of Whitehead's attempt to prompt his readers into revisiting their assumptions about meanings and values. By upending the literary formulas of the detective novel, the heroic folktale, the coming-of-age story, the zombie apocalypse, the slave narrative, and historical fiction, Whitehead reveals the flaws and shortcomings by which Americans have defined themselves. In addition to evoking such explicitly literary storytelling traditions, Whitehead also directs attention toward other interrelated historical and cultural processes that influence how race, class, gender, education, social status, and other categories of identity determine what an individual supposedly can and cannot do.
