Low-carbon Growth Links with China

The Stationery Office China is the fastest growing economy in the world and by 2030 could account for half of the world's CO2 emissions. It has recently set out ambitious plans to reduce the carbon intensity of its economy, boost green energy, draft a new climate law and introduce carbon trading. MPs say that this is the ideal time for the UK to work together with China; both to prepare the ground for a future international agreement and to secure potential opportunities for British businesses in China's burgeoning markets for low-carbon technologies (currently worth around £430 billion). The report warns, however, that the Government's work in China suffers from a lack of strategic direction. There are too many small projects, focused on too many different areas, rather than a coordinated effort to achieve key objectives tailored to appeal to Chinese priorities and which build on UK strengths. For policy, this means a focus on carbon pricing and accounting, where the UK has experience to offer. In the business area this mean identifying the potential markets and technologies in which the UK could have a comparative advantage. One area in which the UK could establish a comparative advantage with the right Government support is carbon, capture and storage (CCS) technology which could be a substantial export earner if the UK is able to develop CCS expertise early. The UK's ability to influence policy in China and to compete for business in low-carbon development depends on the reputation of the UK as a credible leader

A Modified Baseline Incineration Process for Mustard Projectiles at Pueblo Chemical Depot

National Academies Press The United States has maintained a stockpile of chemical warfare agents and munitions since World War I. The Army leadership has sought outside, unbiased advice on how best to dispose of the stockpile. In 1987, at the request of the Under Secretary of the Army, the National Research Council (NRC) established the Committee on Review and Evaluation of the Army Chemical Stockpile Disposal Program (Stockpile Committee) to provide scientific and technical advice and counsel on the CSDP. This report is concerned with the technology selection for the Pueblo site, where only munitions containing mustard agent are stored. The report assesses a modified baseline process, a slightly simplified version of the baseline incineration system that was used to dispose of mustard munitions on Johnston Island. A second NRC committee is reviewing two neutralization-based technologies for possible use at Pueblo. The evaluation in this report is intended to assist authorities making the selection. It should also help the public and other non-Army stakeholders understand the modified baseline process and make sound judgments about it.

His reclusive nature, bashful personality, and overall modesty discouraged publicity and interviewers, leaving large gaps in printed biographical and critical sketches. These omissions have been fleshed out by correspondence with family members and gleanings from contemporary periodicals, helping to present a much more complete picture of the talented author who has amused and terrified so many for so long. This book also contains detailed treatment of the turn-of-the-century literary phenomenon known as the New Humorists. Besides Jacobs, other members of this group included Barry Pain, Jerome K. Jerome, W. Pett Ridge, and Israel Zangwill. As writers who produced comic stories and sketches for the burgeoning popular periodicals of the period, these authors were widely and enthusiastically read by middle and lower class consumers while receiving condescending notice from fashionable literati. Students and scholars of late Victorian and early Edwardian literature, British humor, and turn-of-the-century publishing history will find this useful.
